Apologies had been received from Cllr's Campbell, Cole, Flesher, Naylor and Tennant.

187/12 Disclosures of Interest

189/12 Public Consultation and Question Time, including Police Matters

Police Matters

Reported crime from 13/1/13 to date was:

6 crimes in total, 1 theft from motor vehicle,3 criminal damage, 1 theft of mobile phone, 1 burglary dwelling. Annual Speedwatch statistics were - 54 motorists vehicles had been sent letters regarding speeding, 24 were local residents, 30 were out of area drivers.

Fake £20 notes are in circulation and PC Jacks is collating information on notes detected.

A letter had been received by the Civic Society re the problem parking situation at Aynholme Drive. PC Buckley would request that the area is policed to deter and prevent inconsiderate parking.

Public Consultation

The Member of the public present requested that the Parish Council consider what could be organised for the Tour de France which was coming to Addingham in 2014. Suggestions put forward included setting up a committee, erecting bunting and organising displays. A TDF road show was coming to Ilkley and Members agreed that there would be a Parish Councillor in attendance. BMDC would be contacted to ensure there would be a line of communication established with the Parish Council.

Previous Minutes

Resolved: that the presented Minutes were accepted as a correct record of Addingham Parish Council's Ordinary Meeting held on the 16th January 2013 and they were signed by the Chairman.

Matters Arising

(174/12) Scout Hut/Pavilion – Clerk had met with Council solicitor to go through the draft lease prepared by a legal representative of the Scouts. Some amendments were drafted and the lease was forwarded to the Scout Association for their comment and for the Scouts to review.

(176/12) MUGA lease – although a lease is not required to be in place for the grant applications, the Civic Society request a lease is in place before construction commences. Clerk to forward information to Council's solicitor.

191/12 Scout Hut & Football Pavilion Project

<u>Resolved:</u> Members considered the report prepared by Airedale Fire Protection Services and agreed to implement the recommendations of the report, which also complies with the requirements of the Councils insurance provider.

Consideration of maintenance contracts was withdrawn from the agenda as Contractor quotes had not been provided.

192/12 Annual Parish Meeting

Resolved: the 2013 Annual Parish Meeting will be held on Tuesday 30th April 2013 at the Memorial Hall Addingham, commencing at 7.00 p.m.

193/12 Addingham Civic Society- Proposed MUGA

Members were provided with a verbal update, following a meeting held with representatives of the Civic Society on the 28th January 2013, to discuss the on-going management of the proposed MUGA. Members in attendance: Cllr's Campbell, Coates, Naylor and Mawson.

A meeting had been held between the Civic Society and representatives of the potential user groups, feedback had been positive and they expressed a willingness to get involved and join a management committee. Groups who had expressed a commitment to forming a management committee included; Addingham Cricket Club, Addingham Primary School and Friends of Addingham Primary School, Addigham Youth club and Ilkley tennis club who were keen to provide tennis coaching in the community.

The Civic Society was confident that other sporting groups, e.g. Golf Club, bowling club would join up to form a sports council which could attract further funding streams.

Civic Society confirmed they would organise and fund the insurances required.

A further meeting was to be held with user groups and Cllr Mawson confirmed he would attend on behalf of the Parish Council.

Resolved: Members agreed that there would be a Parish Council representative on the MUGA Management Committee. However the role would be one of observer and not a role such as Treasurer or Chairman. In light of this Members agreed that there would NOT be one designated member but attendance would be determined by a councillor's availability and their other commitments.

Cllr Jerome requested that the Civic Society provide a business plan as one had not been presented to the Parish Council to date.

194/12 Addingham Cricket Club (ACC)

This item was withdrawn from the agenda as the report had not been received by the Council until 5.00 p.m, on the 13th February and Members had not had sufficient time to consider the report. The recommendation would be added to the March 2013 Ordinary Meeting.

195/12 Request for grant funding from Churches Together in Ilkley (CTI) and the Ilkley Community Cafe

Resolved: Members did not award a grant to the above project.

196/12 Parking issues

<u>Resolved</u>: Members agreed that the letter of complaint from the resident of Aynholme Drive should be passed to BMDC for their consideration. A copy of the letter should be forwarded to the school also.

199/12 Chairman's Remarks and Correspondence

Chairman's remarks – following on from discussions for Minute Ref189/12 Public Consultation Members agreed that Bradford MDC should be contacted by the Clerk and a request made for BMDC to impart what preparations they were undertaking for the Tour de France, especially in terms of road closures which will have a significant impact on residents. (E.g. closure of the A65 on the Saturday)

Members of the Parish Council want to be involved with the TDF and want to work with other parties in the village, including the Civic Society, to achieve what will be in the best interests of the village, residents and local businesses. Clerk to liaise with the Gala Committee to ascertain when they will put up the 2014 Gala Day bunting, as it was felt that the bunting could be utilized for the TDF weekend also.

Cllr Jerome would e-mail the Chairman of Addingham Civic Society to reiterate that the Council wanted to work with the Civic Society on the TDF preparations.

Cllr Mawson confirmed that the Cross, to be used for the Easter Celebrations was nearly complete.

Cllr Coates thanked members for attending the Scout Hut/Pavilion opening in particular Cllr Mawson and Hindle for clearing the access in particularly difficult snow conditions.

Members confirmed that the scouts could put up paper towel holders, which the Council would provide. Cllr Coates to inform Scout Group.
